• Be a United States citizen or be lawfully present in the U.S.

• Live in the plan's service area

When do I use this form?

You can join a plan:

- Between October 15-December 7 each year (for coverage starting January 1)
- Within 3 months of first getting Medicare
- In certain situations where you're allowed to join or switch plans

What do I need to complete this form?

- Your Medicare Number (the number on your red, white, and blue Medicare card)
- Your permanent address and phone number

If you want to join a plan during fall open enrollment (October 15-December 7), the plan must get your completed form by December 7.

Your plan will send you a bill for the plan's premium. You can choose to sign up to have your premium payments deducted from your bank account or your monthly Social Security (or Railroad Retirement Board) benefit.
